## Iguazu Rainforests, Falls and Rivers

The most complete tour in the Iguazu Falls area. Enjoy the unique view of 275 falls surrounded by the exuberant virgin jungle of the Iguazu National Park, which protects over 200 species of flora and 400 species of birds and wild animals. It is also a special environment for countless adventure activities. Escape from the mainstream flow of tourists and relax at Yacutinga Lodge in the heart of the rainforest, a unique place surrounded by mysterious wild life.

### Day 1: Arrive in Iguazu



Reception at the local airport and transfer to Sheraton International Hotel within the Iguazú National Park. These magnificent falls, surrounded by the most exuberant subtropical forest, have been included by UNESCO among the Natural Monuments considered World Heritage Site. Visit to the Brazilian side for a panoramic view of the falls, framed by a myriad of rainbows. Optional tour: Safari along the Macuco Trail, to get in touch with the secrets of the rainforest. Return to the hotel. Dinner.

### Day 2: Iguazu Falls

Breakfast. In the morning, excursion to the Argentine Falls, walking along the upper and lower paths to get a really close view of the imposing 275 waterfalls, which cascade down from a height of 70 meters (230 feet). The environment is also exquisite due to the amazing variety of ferns, orchids, begonias, birds and butterflies. In the afternoon, we will take an open train departing from the Visitor Center to the 'Garganta Station' where we will get off for a 1200 meter (less than one mile) walk up to the Devil's Throat balcony, to share one of the greatest shows on earth. Later on, we will return by train to the Visitor Center. Once there we will experience the 'Great Adventure', a brief navigation which will allow you to approach the bottom of the San Martin and Tres Mosqueteros falls and endure an outstanding view of the Devil's Throat. Return to the hotel. Dinner.

### Day 3: Yacutinga Lodge

Breakfast. Excursion to Iguazú forest. This place has exclusive ecotur resources along interpretative geobotanical circuits, giant and strangulating trees, natural palmettoes, giant ferns (arborescents) and ecological bridges. Some very interesting activities such as trekking, abseiling or tyrolese can be practised in this forest reserve. 2.30 p.m. transportation from Puerto Iguazú - Raíces Argentinas - in modern vans traveling through Urugua-I Provincial Park and rural areas of Yerba mate plantations. In the 145-km distance covered along a paved road the landscape combines small towns and Forest. During this trip, the Guide will explain the environmental problems of the region and the importance of Natural Areas Conservation. Arrival at Yacutinga Lodge & Wildlife Nature Reserve (570 hectares of deep jungle, 520 species of butterflies, 320 species of birds, more than 90 species of orchids & bromeliads) reception, room distribution. Dinner. Night walk, "The Forest at night". This excursion aims at sharpening our senses. Surrounded by owls, and a beautiful sky filled with shining stars.

### Day 4: Yacutinga Lodge

Early in the morning Boating along the San Francisco stream, which flows into the Natural Reserve. This is the right moment for a photosafari and general fauna observation. Floating lasts almost 3 hours, silently going through the Gallery forest area. Back to the Lodge at mid-morning. Lunch. Free time to walk along and simply enjoy the facilities of the Lodge (swimming pool, observation towers where one can go up high and stand 5 metres away from the birds, hanging walkway, Visitors center, etc.). Interpretative walks in the afternoon, conducted by expert guides who provide good information on the several natural environments, their Flora and Fauna. Back to the Lodge. Dinner



### Day 5: Yacutinga Lodge - Return Iguazu Falls

Breakfast and free time to explore around or simply enjoy the Lodge area. Brunch at the Lodge and return to Iguazú port by land at mid-morning. Arrival estimated at 1:00 p.m.

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**Included:** 2 nights at Iguazu, 2 nights at Yacutinga, meals/ excursions/ transfers as per the itinerary. Private services with local guides.

**Not included:** International and domestic Air Fare, airport taxes, meals not mentioned, gratuities and personal expenses.
