Suasi Island, Titicaca

A chance to cross the altiplano from Cuzco to Puno and then visit Suasi Island in Lake Titicaca, to see life on the world's highest navigable lake firsthand.

Day 1: Arrive in Cusco - Puno

Transfer from the hotel to the bus station. Assistance on departure Bus ride to Puno along the dramatic landscapes of the highland plateau.

We will stop at Andahuaylillas, a beautiful baroque church built at the beginning of the XVIIth century and very well known thanks to its beautiful mural paintings. We will stop also at the archeological site of Pucara (200BC-AD300) as well as in Raqchi an Inca temple built to worship Wiracocha, one of the most important Inca gods. We will have lunch on a restaurant on route. Upon arriving in Puno, we will provide you with assistance at the bus station and transportation to the selected hotel. -/L/-



Day 2: Puno Lake Titicaca - Suasi

Breakfast at the hotel. Early departure from the port of Puno. First visit the floating islands of Uros. These interesting islands are made of totora, a local reed. Next stop at Taquile Island, inhabited by a quechua community. Learn about their impressive textile tradition and clever social system. Finally arrive on the beautiful island of Suasi. Suasi is a private island which has been passed through the Giraldo family. Today, Martha Giraldo owns it. Ms Giraldo has built a beautiful ecolodge on the island as part of a project that she has been developing. Spend the night in this spectacular place at Casa Andina Private Collection Hotel. Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner.

Day 3: Suasi



Breakfast at the hotel. The previous day we will have witnessed an unforgettable sunset over the island. Today the sunrise is equally impressive. We are on the island of Suasi, in Lake Titicaca. Suasi is a private island belonging to a native of Puno called Martha Giraldo, who has built a beautiful hotel where concepts are applied to tourism. Today is a free day and activities include fishing, climbing, walking and observing the native camelids. For those interested in the esoteric, Suasi has a special energy, according to international experts. B/L/D

Day 4: Suasi - Puno - Juliaca - Fly out from Lima

Breakfast at the hotel. We leave Suasi by car to Juliaca to take our flight back to Lima. Breakfast / box Lunch included.
