### Day 1: Arrival in Cancun

Upon arrival, welcome and transfer to your hotel. Overnight

### Day 2: Cancun (Tulum & Xel-ha)

Today you will take a day trip to Tulum, a beautiful archaeological site on the coast south of Cancun and Xel-Ha, a water theme park. This is the best combination between Mayan histories at Tulum, the only archaeological zone in the area overlooking the ocean and is believed to have been the largest port for the Mayans and the Xel-Ha the most spectacular natural aquarium of the world; you experience the real aquatic adventure. Explore this theme park and enjoy all it has to offer lagoons, natural wells and ancient caves. Return to hotel. Overnight.
